

**Day 1 Friday ~ February 24**  
**DESTINATION ISRAEL**

**NOTE NEW DEPARTURE DATE AIR CANADA SCHEDULE CHANGE**

8:15am Meet in Moncton airport at the Air Canada check in counter for your 10:15am flight to Toronto. Leave Toronto at 5:20pm on your Air Canada overnight nonstop flight at destination Israel. Meals served on board.

**Day 2 Saturday ~ February 25**  
**WELCOME TO ISRAEL**

Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport at 11am. Meet your guide. Drive north through the Plain of Sharon, along the Mediterranean shore on the old coastal road known in Roman times as the Via Maris, which linked Egypt and Babylon, en route to the Galilee. Stop at Caesarea, the Roman capital and the largest port in the Mediterranean built by King Herod the Great. Here Pontius Pilate had his seat; Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30) and Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City and view an impressive Audio visual presentation. View the summit of Mount Carmel at Muhraka the "burning place" where Elijah confronted the 450 prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:30). Enjoy a welcome dinner and get a good night's rest. **Overnight Ein Gev Sea of Galilee - 4 nights** (Dinner)

**Day 3 Sunday ~ February 26**  
**JEWELS OF JESUS' MINISTRY**

Start that day at the Mt Beatitudes where Jesus delivered the famous "Sermon On The Mount" (Matt.5) enjoy a picturesque stroll down to the shore of the Sea of Galilee to the Church of The Primacy of Peter (Tabgha) and the Church of the Feeding of the Multitude. Proceed to Kfar Nahum Capernaum centre of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee and the site of many of his miracles (Mark 2:4; Matt.8:5; 14-7; 9; 1-7; 17: 18). See the remains of St Peter's (mother in law's) home and the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mark 1:21; Luke 4:31). View the famous ancient boat from the time of Jesus. Following the tradition of the "fishermen" disciples, sail on the Sea of Galilee with time for meditation and prayer. (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 4 Monday ~ February 27**  
**GALILEE**

Stop in Nazareth - visit Nazareth Historical Village – relive village life from the time of Jesus. View the Church of Annunciation and travel via Cana of the Wedding feast site of the 1<sup>st</sup> miracle. Travel to Ibillin to visit the unique Mar Elias Educational Institution a shining beacon of hope for all people of the Holy Land 11:30am. Continue to Sepphoris –visit the aqueducts, then walk through the extensive excavation. Proceed to the Arbel Cliffs for a spectacular view of the Sea of Galilee. Time permitting stop to on the Golan Heights to visit Hippos (Susitta) on "the other side" one of the cities of Decapolis (ten cities)." (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 5 Tuesday ~ February 28**  
**NORTHERN EXTENT OF JESUS' MINISTRY**

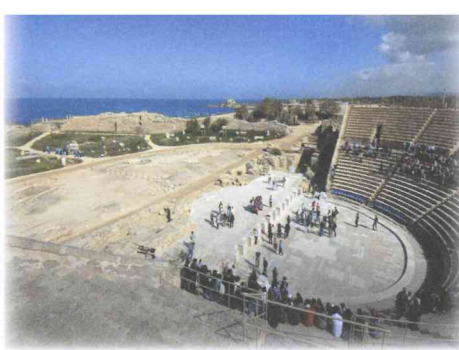
Travel North – onto the Golan Heights visit the Golan Heights winery. View the armistices line with Syria and Lebanon. Visit Kalat Nimrod a unique Crusader/Moslem fortress and walk down the mountain to Baniyas to visit Caesarea Philippi where Jesus asked, "Who do men say I am?" Proceed to Dan visit the nature reserve and ancient site including a mud brick gate from the time of Abraham (Genesis 14: 14). (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 6 Wednesday ~ February 29**  
**FROM THE GALILEE TO THE DEAD SEA**

Travel south along the Jordan Valley to Beit Shean first mentioned in the book of Samuel, where the body of King Saul and his sons were placed on the walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10) also known in Jesus day as Scythopolis, capital of Decapolis. View the largest ongoing archaeological excavation in Israel with ruins of the Roman / Byzantine / Omayyad cities. Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus & the Galileans took through the homeland of Prophet Elisha down the Jordan Valley, where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:1-2). Descend via the Judean Desert along the shore of the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth (417 meters below sea level) stop to visit Qumran ruins of a possible Essene community site of the first discovery of the Dead Sea scrolls (in a nearby cave). View the Oasis at Ein Gedi. **Overnight & dinner Ganim Isrotel Spa Hotel Dead Sea - 1 night** (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 7 Thursday ~ March 1**  
**FROM THE DEAD SEA TO EILAT**

After breakfast spend a leisurely morning in the spa at the hotel including a unique experience, "float" in the Dead Sea – you cannot sink! Visit Masada ruins of King Herod the Great's mountaintop fortress later the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans in 73 C.E. (Ascend and descend by cable car). Travel south along the Dead Sea view the pillar of Lot's wife (Genesis) and relate to the epic destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah. Continue via the Arava valley and the Negev wilderness to Timna to visit the Timna Valley Park site of ancient copper mines from the time of the Pharaohs including Solomon's pillars and the Tabernacle in the



Wilderness ~ a full scale replica of the Biblical Tabernacle which will make Leviticus come alive. End the day in Eilat the resort city on the Red Sea. **Overnight Crown Plaza Hotel Eilat – 3 nights** (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 8 Friday ~ March 2**

**EILAT**

Take an optional excursion (day trip) to Petra can be arranged directly with the tour operator at an additional cost. Visit some local attractions – Underwater Observatory or Swim with Dolphin. (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 9 Saturday ~ March 3**

**EILAT**

Enjoy a free day in Eilat to take in such activities as swimming with the dolphins, visiting a camel farm, the aquarium and underwater observatory. Relax on the beach, bath in the Red Sea or snorkel at a spectacular easily accessible coral reef.

**Day 10 Sunday ~ March 4**

**FROM EILAT TO JERUSALEM**

Travel along the Border with Egypt en route to Mitzpeh Ramon. Stop to view biblical Kadesh Barnea. Continue to Borot Luts to see how water was gathered in the Negev desert. Visit the Machtsh Ramon visitor's centre enjoy a breathtaking view of this unique geological window found only in Israel and Jordan. Walk through/up Ein Avdat and view the majestic Wilderness of Zinn. Continue via Beersheva of Abraham's covenant fame to Jerusalem. **Overnight King Solomon Hotel – 4 nights** (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 11 Monday ~ March 5**

**JERUSALEM**

Explore King David's City including the multimedia, Warren's Shaft, the Canaanite tunnel and the Pools of Siloam. Visit the Ophel Archaeological Garden & the Davidson Center (combining archaeological exhibit & computerized Second Temple presentation) including a stop on the very same ancient steps that Jesus & the Galilean pilgrims used to enter and exit the Holy Temple. Stop at the Western Wall (Kotel) Judaism's most sacred site. Take a Journey back in time through the Western Wall Tunnels. Visit the Israel Museum including the model of Jerusalem from the time of Jesus. Pay respect to the victims of the Shoah at Yad Vashem – National Memorial & Museum of the Holocaust, including: the unique new Museum, the Valley of the Communities & the Children's Memorial. (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 12 Tuesday ~ March 6**

**JERUSALEM**

View the city and Temple Mt from the Mt. Olives. Follow in the footsteps of Jesus and the Galileans on the route of Palm Sunday walk down the Mt. via Dominus Flevitt to visit Gethsemane - the Church of All Nations with time for reflection and prayer in the Olive orchard and the Grotto of Gethsemane. Continue across the Kidron valley via St Stephen's (the Lions) Gate, to the pools of Bethesda - St Anne's church where Jesus healed the paralytic man then walk along the Via Dolorosa the Stations of the Cross en route to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Proceed through the "Suk" (the colourful Arab market) and Zion gate to St Peter in Gallicantu built on the site of Caiaphas house where Jesus was imprisoned during the night of his trial. End the day on Mt. Zion visit the Church of the Last Supper (the upper chamber). (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 13 Wednesday ~ March 7**

**JERUSALEM**

Spend a day of leisure in this fascinating city with time to revisit places of interest and do some shopping in the colourful "Suk" (Market Place) in the Old City. Options to consider (on your own), visit the Church of the Nativity in Bethlehem\* the birthplace of Jesus and Shepherd's Field; stroll through the Orthodox community in Meah Shearim; the Mahane Yehuda market; David's Tower; Ramparts of the Old City; the Temple Institute housing furniture and instruments ready for the Third Temple; Rockefeller Museum; Augusta Victory; the Anglican and Lutheran churches. Enjoy a farewell dinner in the hotel. (Breakfast & dinner)

**Day 14 Thursday ~ March 8**

**DESTINATION CANADA**

Transfer to the airport for your return flight. Depart Tel Aviv at 12:55pm (afternoon) on your direct nonstop Air Canada flight arriving at Pearson International Airport in Toronto at 6:25pm. Continue on your Air Canada flight to Moncton arriving at
