



Day 1 ~ Wednesday February 29

DEPART CANADA

8am Meet in Calgary airport at the Air Canada counter to check in for your flight to Toronto departing 10am. Arrive in Toronto's Pearson International airport terminal 1 at 3:40pm. Depart for Tel Aviv on a nonstop flight from Toronto at 5:20pm overnight (meals served on route).

Day 2 ~ Thursday March 1

ARRIVE IN ISRAEL

11:15am Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport, clear customs and immigration and meet with your guide. Travel north to visit Caesarea, the Roman capital and port where Paul was imprisoned and the first gentile was converted. Tour the historical site and enjoy an audio visual presentation showing the history of how Caesarea was built and operated as a port city. Transfer to your hotel on the Mediterranean Sea in the unique Akko Bay, remainder of the day to relax or walk along the Mediterranean shore. **Overnight: Palm Beach Hotel Akko x 1 [Dinner]**

Day 3 ~ Friday March 2

CARMEL / GALILEE

Drive along the Jezreel Valley view Mt Carmel and the Muhraka (Mt Carmel) where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal en route to Megiddo, visit one of King Solomon's fortified city kingdoms (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), with impressive ruins of 21 levels of civilization. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as you read about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the fertile plains of the Jezreel. Travel to Nazareth view the Church of Annunciation visit Nazareth Village describing village life from the time of Jesus. Travel to Yardenit for baptism in the Jordan River then continue to the Sea of Galilee. Following the tradition of the "fishermen" disciples sail on the Sea of Galilee. Stop to visit the famous "Jesus Boat". **Overnight: Ein Gev hotel – Sea of Galilee x 2 [breakfast & dinner]**

Day 4 ~ Saturday March 3

GALILEE

Travel up the Jordan Valley to Dan, visit this ancient biblical site including the mud brick gate that Abraham might have used to enter the city. Visit Caesarea Philippi (Banias), where Jesus asked, "Who do men say I am?" Travel across the Golan Heights to the areas of Jesus' Ministry around the Sea of Galilee central, stop to visit Chorazin one of the three villages Jesus prophesied over for not accepting his teaching. Weather permitting - walk along the Northern shore of the Sea of Galilee in the path of Jesus and the disciples to Kfar Nahum, Capernaum home of Simon Peter. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 5 ~ Sunday March 4

GALILEE / JORDAN

Travel South through the Jordan Valley to the Sheikh Hussein Bridge and cross into Jordan. Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus and the Galileans took through Poreah and the mountains of Gilad, stop at Ajloun to visit a Moslem desert fortress. Continue to Jerash – view the ruins of the Roman city. Proceed to Madaba study the unique mosaic map of the world from the Byzantine era. Stop at Mt. Nevo where emulating the children of Israel and Moses you'll get a glimpse of the Promised Land. Continue through the Moab mountains south to Petra. **Overnight and dinner La Maison hotel Petra x 1 [breakfast & dinner]**

Day 6 ~ Monday March 5

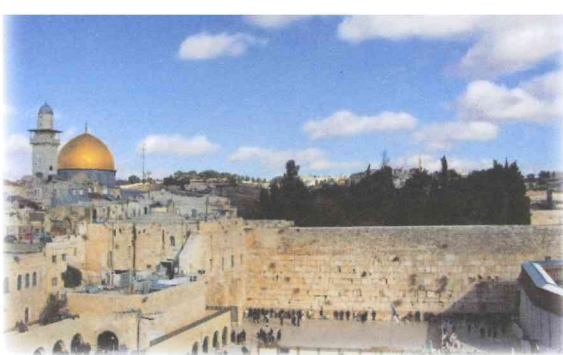
PETRA

Get an early start, walking and riding into the centre of the ancient Nabatean capital one of the seven wonders of the ancient world. See the stunning charm of the Necropolis and magnificent sandstone. Mid afternoon leave Petra travelling south on the Kings Way toward Akaba and cross into Israel at the Arava terminal Follow in the footsteps of the children of Israel descend via the Arava Desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth (417 meters below sea level). Drive along the shores of the Dead Sea via Sodom and Amorrhah. **Overnight and dinner Le Meridien Dead Sea Spa hotel x 1 [breakfast & dinner]**

Day 7 ~ Tuesday March 6

DEAD SEA / JERUSALEM

Enjoy a unique experience "float" in the Dead Sea you cannot sink! At noon visit Masada, tour ruins of King Herod the Great's mountaintop fortress and the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans in 73 C.E. View the oasis at Ein Gedi – famous from David fleeing the wrath of King Saul. Visit Qumran, home of the



Cult of the Judean Desert, where a shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls (1947) in a nearby cave. Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus and the Galileans took ascend through the Judean Desert en route to Jerusalem. Stop on Mount Scopus for your first view of the Holy City and to recite Psalm 122. **Overnight & dinner Rimmonim Shalom x 6** [breakfast & dinner]

Day 8 ~Wednesday March 7

JERUSALEM

Start the day in Bethlehem, visiting the Church of the Nativity, which marks the birthplace of Jesus view Shepherds Field. Proceed to the Mt of Olives for a wonderful view of the Old and New Cities. Following the route of Palm Sunday walk down to Gethsemane visit the church marking the site of the betrayal of Jesus and spend some time in an adjacent Olive Grove with time for prayer and reflection. Pay respect to the victims of the Shoah (Holocaust) at Yad Vashem, National Memorial and Museum of the Holocaust, including the New Museum, and the Children's Memorial. Visit the Israel Museum to see the Model of Jerusalem, to learn about the city from the time of Jesus and to visit the Shrine of the Book home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 9 ~ Thursday March 8

JERUSALEM

Explore the fascinating new on going excavations in David's City including the audio visual, Warren's shaft, the Canaanite tunnel and the pool of Siloam. Enter the Old City and visit the Southern wall archaeological Park stand on the original ancient steps which led up to the Holy Temple including the Davidson Museum. to the Western Wall stop for reflection at the most important Jewish site. Walk back in time through the fascinating Western Wall tunnels. Visit the Garden Tomb remember the resurrection, with time for prayer (communion) and reflection. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 10 ~ Friday March 9

JERUSALEM

Spend the day at leisure. Enjoy free time to re-visit the Old City, shop or walk through the new city for shopping along Jaffa Road and Ben Yehuda Street. Visit one of the many Museums that Jerusalem has to offer or simply relax at the hotel. Visit the Western Wall to witness the blessing of the Sabbath Bride. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 11 ~ Saturday March 10

JERUSALEM

Enter the Old City through St Stephen's (Lions) Gate and walk to the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the paralytic man at St Anne's Church. Continue through the Suk (market) for a short visit at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre and through the Ancient alleyways of the Old City via the Cardo (Roman Main Street). Stop on Mt Zion to visit King David's Tomb and for reflection at the Church of the Last Supper site of the Pentecost. Proceed to St Peter in Gallicantu Church built on the site of High priest Caiaphas' home, where Jesus was imprisoned and Peter denied Jesus. Continue to Herodium visit a remarkable desert fortress, site of King Herod the Great's tomb. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 12 ~ Sunday March 11

JERUSALEM

Spend the day at leisure in this fascinating city. Visit one of the many Museums that Jerusalem has to offer or simply relax at the hotel. Enjoy a farewell dinner in the hotel. [Breakfast & dinner]

Day 13 ~ Monday March 12

RETURN TO CANADA

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your return flight to Canada. Leave Tel Aviv for Toronto at 11:45am meals served on board. Arrive in Toronto at 6:25pm continue on the Air Canada flight to Calgary 8:30pm arriving in Calgary at 10:40pm.
