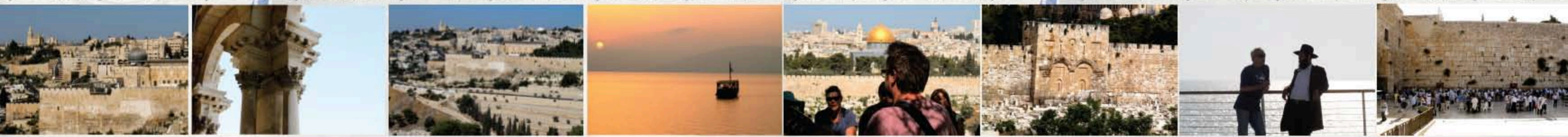

DAY 1 SUN. | MAY 6 | Journey to Israel

Meet at the EL AL check-in counter at LA International Airport at 9:00am. Your experience begins when you depart from LAX at 12:30pm for Israel flying nonstop on EL AL, Israel's national airline - meals served on board. En route overnight.

DAY 2 MON. | MAY 7 | Welcome to Israel

Arrive at Ben Gurion Airport at 2:00pm meet your driver and guide. Transfer to the hotel in Tel Aviv and have some time before dinner for a walk along the shores of the Mediterranean. Overnight Dan Panorama Tel Aviv [Dinner]

DAY 3 TUES. | MAY 8 | The Galilee

Drive along the Mediterranean Coast to Caesarea, where Paul defended himself before Festus and King Agrippa (Acts 25:6-26:32) and Cornelius was baptized by Peter (Acts 10:1-48). Visit the theater, palace, hippodrome, crusader ruins and view the multimedia presentation. Continue northeast on to Mt. Carmel to where Elijah challenged the 450 prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:20-46). Travel along the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's "city kingdoms" with 21 layers of civilization, site of the Apocalyptic Battle of Amageddon (Revelation 16:12-16). Time permitting; conclude the day with a breathtaking view from Mount Arbel, located on the northwest corner of the Sea of Galilee. For those who wish, an opportunity will be given to climb down the mountain, a wonderful experience. Those not wanting to do so, can have the time for coffee and pastries at a nearby restaurant. Three nights at the Hotel in Galilee [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 4 WED. | MAY 9 | Sea of Galilee

Spend time in prayer and teaching on the Mount of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered The Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). Visit sites central to Jesus' ministry around the Sea of Galilee including: Capernaum, where Jesus chose to center His ministry (Luke 4:16-32) and Korazin, the town Jesus pronounced judgment on for rejecting Him and His ministry (Matthew 11:20-24) and Tagbha. Enjoy a special St. Peter's fish lunch treat. Travel along the Sea of Galilee to the South side and stop at Yardenit for a baptismal service in the Jordan (Matthew 3:13-17). Drive past Ein Dor where King Saul visited the sorceress (1 Samuel 28:4-25) to Gideon's Spring (Ein Harod) where Gideon selected 300 men to join him in the battle with the Midianites (Judges 7:1-7). [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 5 THURS. | MAY 10 | Golan Heights/Sea of Galilee

Travel North to the ancient City of Dan where Jeroboam set up an altar after leading the rebellion against King Rehoboam and the

Southern Kingdom of Judah (1 Kings 12:25-33). Continue to Banias the northern extent of Jesus' ministry, site of Caesarea Philippi where Peter confessed Jesus as the Christ (Matthew 16:13-20). Drive onto the Golan Heights to the Northern Altar. Visit the Valley of Tears to learn about one of the most significant tank battles in Israel's short history and the valor of the 7th ~ Oz (Might) Battalion, then continue across the Golan Heights and down the Jordan Valley. Stop to visit the Ancient 2000 year old Boat then, emulating the "fishermen disciples," sail on the Sea of Galilee. [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 6 FRI. | MAY 11 | Sea of Galilee/Jerusalem

Visit Beit Shean where the body of King Saul and his sons were placed on the walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:8-13). Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus and the Galileans took down the Jordan Valley where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:1-2), through the homeland of Prophet Elisha. Travel via Jericho (which you will see from afar), lowest city in the world, and through the Wilderness of Judea to Genesis Land to visit "Abraham" (4000 years later ~ Genesis 18:1-8), ride camels and experience typical Bedouin hospitality in a tent overlooking the Jordan Valley. Enter the Holy City Jerusalem as the Galilean pilgrims did and enjoy the first glimpse of the city from Mt. Scopus and recite a Psalm of Ascent (Psalm 122:1-9). Continue on to Golgotha where Jesus was crucified (John 19:17&18), and the Garden Tomb where He was buried (Luke 23:50-56) and rose again (Luke 24:1-7). End the day with a communion service in the garden. [Breakfast/dinner] 5 nights at the Dan Regency Hotel

DAY 7 SAT. | MAY 12 | Dead Sea/Masada

Visit the Southern Altar. Travel north along the Dead Sea to Masada to visit the ruins of King Herod's mountaintop fortress and the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans in 73 CE. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the excavations, including the ancient synagogue, Herod's palace, water cisterns and bathhouses and enjoy the desert vistas from above. Visit Ein Gedi - oasis where David hid from the wrath of King Saul (1 Samuel 23:29). Stop for a unique experience - "float" in the Dead Sea. You cannot sink! Continue to Qumran, home of the Cult of the Judean Desert, where a shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls (1947) in a nearby cave. After dinner meet for prayer and teaching in the hotel. [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 8 SUN. | MAY 13 | Jerusalem

Begin the day on the Mt. of Olives with a spectacular view of the "Golden City" (Acts 1:1-12) where Jesus began His Palm Sunday journey into Jerusalem (Matthew 21:1-9). Follow the route of Palm Sunday; walk down the hillside, via Dominus Flevit where Jesus lamented the destruction of the Temple (Luke 19:37-42). Continue into the Kidron Valley (John 18:1) to the Garden of Gethsemane where

Jesus spent the night in prayer (Matthew 26:36-46). Stop in the Olive grove for prayer and teaching. Visit the City of David (2 Samuel 5:8-10) the oldest inhabited part of Jerusalem including a wonderful 3D audio visual presentation, the fascinating, ongoing excavations, Hezekiah's Tunnel (2 Kings 20:20) and walk through a Canaanite tunnel to the Pool of Siloam (John 9:1-11). Proceed to Mt. Zion, stop at King David's Tomb (Acts 2:29). Then visit the Upper Room where Jesus had His Last Supper with His disciples (Luke 22:7-38). Visit the House of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Jesus was tried by the Sanhedrin and imprisoned for a night (Matthew 26:57-75, John 18:12-14). Enter the Old City through Zion Gate, walk back in time, visiting the restored Jewish quarter, The Cardo (main street from 2000 years ago) and the Broad Wall (Isaiah 22:9-11). Tour the Temple Mount Institute to see replicas of the instruments used in the worship of the Temple, continue through the ancient alleyways and colorful market place to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 9 MON. | MAY 14 | Jerusalem

Visit the Davidson Centre and the Southern Wall Archaeological Park to walk on the steps that Jesus and the disciples used to walk in and out of the temple. (Matthew 21:12-13). Stop at the Western Wall, Judaism's most venerated site. Walk back in time through the Western Wall Rabbinical Tunnels. Visit the Pools of Bethesda at St. Anne's Church with time for prayer and teaching. Continue to the Israel Museum to visit the Model of Jerusalem from Jesus' day and the Shrine of the Book, home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Pay tribute to the six million Jews who perished in the Shoah at Yad Vashem, the

Spend the day at leisure in Jerusalem, shop in the old or new city, relax in the hotel or revisit places of interest. Following the farewell dinner in the hotel, transfer to the airport for your return flight. [Breakfast/dinner]

DAY 11 WED. | MAY 16 | Return to the USA

Leave Tel Aviv at 1:55am flying nonstop on EL AL to LA. Arrive at LAX Airport at 6:35pm.
