



Day 1 ~ May 16, Wednesday **DEPART CANADA**

11:30am Meet in Halifax airport at the Air Canada counter to check in for your flight to Toronto departing 1:55pm. Arrive in Toronto's Pearson International airport at 3:10pm. Depart for Tel Aviv on a nonstop overnight flight from Toronto at 5:45pm meals served en route.

Day 2 ~ May 17, Thursday **ARRIVE IN ISRAEL**

11:15am Arrive at Ben Gurion International Airport, clear customs and immigration and meet with your guide. Travel north to visit Caesarea, the Roman capital and port. Here Pontius Pilate had his seat; Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30) and Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Tour the historical site and enjoy an audio visual presentation showing the history of how Caesarea was built and operated as a port city. Transfer to your hotel on the Mediterranean Sea in the unique Akko Bay, remainder of the day to relax or walk along the Mediterranean shore. **Overnight: Palm Beach Hotel Akko x 1 night** [Dinner]

Day 3 ~ May 18, Friday **CARMEL / GALILEE**

Drive along the Jezreel Valley visit Mt Carmel and the Muhraka (Mt Carmel) where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal en route to Megiddo, one of King Solomon's fortified city kingdoms (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), visit impressive ruins of 21 levels of civilization. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as you read about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the fertile plains of the Jezreel. Travel to Nazareth view the Church of Annunciation visit Nazareth Village describing village life from the time of Jesus. Travel to Yardenit for baptism in the Jordan River then continue to the Sea of Galilee. Following the tradition of the "fishermen" disciples sail on the Sea of Galilee then stop to visit the famous "Jesus Boat". **Overnight: Leonardo hotel – Tiberias x 2 nights** [breakfast/dinner]

Day 4 ~ May 19, Saturday **GALILEE**

Travel up the Jordan Valley along the Golan Heights to Dan to visit this ancient biblical site including the mud brick gate that Abraham might have used to enter the city. Visit Caesarea Philippi (Banias), where Jesus asked, "Who do men say I am?" Travel onto and across the Golan Heights going south to sites central to Jesus' Ministry, stop to visit Chorazin one of the three villages Jesus prophesied over for not accepting his teaching. Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered "The Sermon On The Mount" (Matt.5). Walk down the mountain to Tabgha to visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter. Walk along the Northern shore of the Sea of Galilee in the path of Jesus and the disciples to Kfar Nahum, Capernaum centre of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee and the site of many of his miracles (Mark 2:4; Matt.8:5; 14-7; 9; 1-7; 17: 18) with remains of St Peter's house, and the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mark 1:21; Luke 4:31). [breakfast/dinner]

Day 5 ~ May 20, Sunday **GALILEE / JERUSALEM**

Travel south along the Jordan Valley stop to visit Beit Shean the largest archaeological excavation in Israel where the Philistines placed the bodies of King Saul and his sons on the city walls (1 Samuel 31:10), visit the ruins of the Roman/Byzantine/Omayyad cities. Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus & the Galileans took down the Jordan Valley through the homeland of Prophet Elisha where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:1-2). Then ascend through the Judean Desert stop at Genesis Land to visit Abraham's tent, enjoy typical Bedouin hospitality, lunch and camel rides. Continue to the Holy City stop on Mount Scopus for your first view of Jerusalem and to recite Psalm 122. End the day in Bethlehem, visiting the Church of the Nativity, which marks the birthplace of Jesus and view Shepherds Field. **Overnight Leonardo hotel Jerusalem x 6 nights** [breakfast/dinner]



Day 6 ~ May 21, Monday

JERUSALEM

Stop on the Mt of Olives for a wonderful view of the Old and New Cities. Following the route of Palm Sunday walk down to Gethsemane visit the church marking the site of the betrayal of Jesus and spend some time in an adjacent Olive Grove with time for prayer and reflection. Continue through the Valley of Jehoshaphat and enter the Old City through the Dung Gate to the Western Wall stop for reflection at the most important Jewish site. Walk back in time through the fascinating Western Wall tunnels to the Pools of Bethesda where Jesus healed the paralytic man. Continue through the Suk (market) stop for a short visit at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre then stroll through the Ancient alleyways via the Cardo (Roman Main Street) to Zion Gate. [breakfast/dinner]

Day 7 ~ May 22, Tuesday

JERUSALEM

Walk along the Ramparts - the city Walls - from the Damascus Gate to the Dung Gate. Explore the fascinating ongoing excavations in David's City including the audio visual, Warren's shaft, Hezekiah's (in water) or the Canaanite tunnel and the pool of Siloam. Enter the Old City and visit the Southern wall archaeological Park where one can stand on the original ancient steps which Jesus walked on up to the Holy Temple including the Davidson Museum. Continue to Mt Zion to visit King David's Tomb and the Church of the Last Supper site of the Pentecost. [breakfast/dinner]

Day 8 ~ May 23, Wednesday

JERUSALEM

Visit the Supreme Court then walk through the Rose Garden stop at the Menorah and view the Knesset en route to the Israel Museum. Visit the Model of Jerusalem to learn about the city from the time of Jesus and to visit the Shrine of the Book home of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Pay respect to the victims of the Holocaust at Yad Vashem, National Memorial and Museum of the Holocaust, including the New Museum, and the Children's Memorial. Continue to Herodion visit a remarkable desert fortress, site of King Herod's tomb. Stop at the Hass / Sherover Promenade for a fascinating view of the city Old and new. End the day at the Garden Tomb remember the resurrection, with time for prayer (communion) and reflection. [breakfast/dinner]

Day 9 ~ May 24, Thursday

DEAD SEA

Descend via the Judean Desert to the Dead Sea, the lowest place on earth (417 meters below sea level). Visit Qumran, home of the Cult of the Judean Desert, where a shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls (1947) in a nearby cave. Continue south to Masada to tour the impressive ruins of King Herod the Great's mountaintop fortress, the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans in 73 C.E. Visit the oasis at Ein Gedi - famous from David fleeing the wrath of King Saul en route to Mineral Beach to enjoy a unique experience "float" in the Dead Sea you cannot sink! Follow the pilgrimage route that Jesus and the Galileans took via the Judean Desert returning to Jerusalem. [breakfast/dinner]

Day 10 ~ May 25, Friday

JERUSALEM

Spend the day at leisure in this fascinating city. Enjoy free time to re-visit the Old City, shop in the bazaars, or walk through the new city for shopping along Jaffa Road and Ben Yehuda Street. Visit one of the many Museums that Jerusalem has to offer or simply relax at the hotel. Stop at the Western Wall to witness the blessing of the Sabbath Bride. Enjoy a farewell dinner in the hotel. [breakfast/dinner]

Day 11 ~ May 26, Saturday

RETURN TO CANADA

After breakfast transfer to the airport for your return flight to Canada. Leave Tel Aviv for Toronto at 1:10pm meals served on board. Arrive in Toronto at 6:30pm, Continue on the Air Canada flight to Halifax at 8:40pm arriving at 11:37pm.
