

Day 1 – Tuesday September 4

TORONTO

10:00am Meet at Toronto's Pearson International Airport in terminal 3 at the El Al check in counter. Depart at 1.10pm on El Al Israel Airlines, flying non-stop from Toronto to Tel Aviv meals served on board.

Day 2 – Wednesday September 5

WELCOME TO ISRAEL

Arrive in Tel Aviv at 7:15am meet your tour guide. Drive north through the Plain of Sharon, along the Mediterranean shore on the old coastal road known as the Via Maris, which linked Egypt and Babylon, en route to the Galilee. Stop at Caesarea the largest port in the Mediterranean built by King Herod the Great. Here Pontius Pilate had his seat; Cornelius lived and was baptized (Acts 10); Paul embarked to Tarsus (Acts 9:30) and Philip preached (Acts 8:40). Visit the Roman Theatre, the Hippodrome, and the Crusader City. Stop at the visitors' center to view the audio visual. Balance of the day will be at leisure. Walk along the Mediterranean to see the sunset before dinner.

Day 3 – Thursday September 6

TEL AVIV/ JAFFA/ CAESAREA/MT.CARMEL/MEGIDDO

Travel to Muhraka (the burned place) on Mt. Carmel where the prophet Elijah challenged the 400 false prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:30). Drive along the Jezreel Valley to Megiddo one of King Solomon's fortified city kingdoms (1 Kings 9:15; 10:26), with impressive ruins of some 21 levels of civilization. From here the Books of Daniel and Revelation will come alive as you read about the final Battle of Armageddon, while viewing the fertile plains of the Jezreel Valley. Proceed to Nazareth, the boyhood town of Jesus, visit Nazareth Village relive life in a village depicting the time of Jesus and view the Church of the Annunciation. Continue via Cana site of the first miracle changing water into wine. End the day emulating the disciples with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee to Kibbutz Gennosar and visit the ancient boat from the time of Jesus that was discovered in the Sea of Galilee. **Dinner and overnight Rimmonim hotel Tiberias Sea of Galilee x 2 [breakfast & dinner]**

Day 4 – Friday September 7

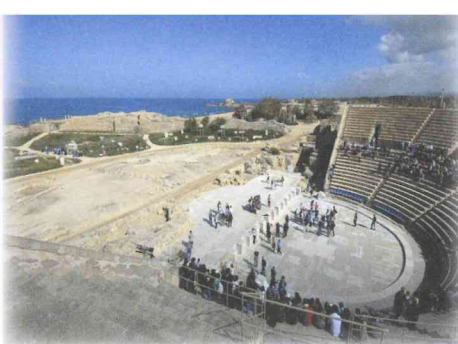
JESUS' MINISTRY IN THE GALILEE

Drive north along the foot of the Golan Heights to visit Banias, one of the sources of the Jordan River, site of ancient "Caesarea Philippi" where Peter made the confession of faith in Christ (Matt; 16:16). Continue to Korazin a village from Jesus' time with ruins of a First Century Synagogue one of three villages Jesus prophesied over "Woe to thee...." Continue to the Mt. of Beatitudes where Jesus delivered "The Sermon On The Mount" (Matt.5) where you walk down the mountain visit the Church of the Primacy of Peter. Proceed to Capernaum centre of Jesus' Ministry in the Galilee and the site of many of his miracles (Mark 2:4; Matt.8:5; 14-7; 9; 1-7; 17: 18). See the remains of St Peter's house and the ancient synagogue where Jesus taught and worshipped (Mark 1:21; Luke 4:31). Time permitting stopping at Kursi ruins of an impressive Byzantine monastery near the miracle of the demonic man and the swine. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 5 – Saturday September 8

ROAD TO JERUSALEM

Visit Yardenit baptism centre on the Jordan River. Travel south to Beit Shean where the body of King Saul and his sons were placed on the walls by the Philistines (1 Samuel 31:10) also known as Scythopolis, capital of Decapolis view the largest ongoing archaeological dig in the land of Israel. Drive through the Jordan Valley, where the desert now blooms with flowers and vegetation of every description (Isaiah 35:1-2). Continue south along the shores of the Dead Sea to Qumran, home of the Cult of the Judean Desert, where a shepherd boy discovered the Dead Sea Scrolls (1947) in a nearby cave. Then ascend through the Judean Desert Wilderness en route to the Holy City - golden Jerusalem as the Galileans did stopping on Mt Scopus to recite a Psalm of Ascent and enjoy the first view of the Holy City. **Dinner and overnight Jerusalem Gate or Rimmonim Shalom hotel - Jerusalem [breakfast & dinner]**



Day 6 – Sunday September 9

OLD CITY OF JERUSALEM

Drive to the top of Mount of Olives, for a panoramic view of Jerusalem. Tracing the footsteps of Jesus, stroll down the Mount of Olives to the Garden of Gethsemane the Church of All Nations. Continue along the Kidron Valley the Valley of Jehoshaphat en route to Mt Zion. Visit the Upper Room (Room of the Last Super), King David's Tomb and the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu, built on the site of High Priest Caiaphas' home. Enter the Old City walking through Zion Gate and the Armenian Quarter to the Jewish Quarter. Visit the Roman/Byzantine/Crusader Street called the "Cardo." Continue down the "Upper Hill" view the Dome of the Rock and Al Aqsa Mosque built on the Temple Mount en route to the Southern Wall Archaeological Park to visit the impressive excavations along the South Western Wall of the Temple Mount. Continue to the Western Wall, Judaism's holiest spot. Stop at the Garden Tomb for communion then join the King of Kings for prayers with the local community. After dinner walk back in time through the Western Wall Tunnels under the city. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 7 – Monday September 10

NEW JERUSALEM/ BETHLEHEM

Start the day at Yad Vashem – national memorial and Museum of the Holocaust, pay tribute to the six million victims of the Shoah in Europe during the Second World War. Visit the new Museum, the Children's Memorial and walk along the Avenue of the Righteous Amongst the Nations commemorating those who risked their own lives to save Jewish souls. Continue to the Israel Museum to visit the Shrine of the Book housing the Dead Sea Scrolls the oldest Bible manuscripts and the Model of ancient Jerusalem describing the city from the Second Temple Period, the time of Jesus. Visit King David's City including a multimedia presentation ruins of King David's city, the Canaanite tunnel and the Pools of Siloam. Walk along the path of Palm Sunday to the Pools of Bethesda at St. Anne's Church and along the Stations of the Cross through the "Suk" the colourful bazaars, alleyways and market places to visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Proceed to Bethlehem birthplace of Jesus to visit the Church of the Nativity the birthplace of Jesus. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 8 – Tuesday September 11

MASADA/ DEAD SEA

Drive through the Judean desert towards Jericho, the oldest town in the world which you will see from a distance to the lowest point on earth the Dead Sea (over 1300 feet below sea level). Continue south to Masada. Ascend by cable car to the summit of King Herod the Great's desert fortress, later the last stronghold of the Jewish Zealots in the revolt against Rome(73 ace). Travel north along the Dead Sea en route to Jerusalem stop at Mineral Beach to float on the Dead Sea the saltiest body of water in world – you cannot sink! Then ascend through the Judean Desert Wilderness stop at Genesis Land to experience Abraham in the wilderness, enjoy camel rides and folklore. Return to Jerusalem. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 9 – Wednesday September 12

JERUSALEM

Spend a day of leisure in this fascinating city. Check out of the hotel at noon (luggage can be left with security). Time to re-visit the Old City for shopping in the bazaars or walk through the new city for shopping along Jaffa Road and Ben Yehuda Street. Visit one of the many Museums that Jerusalem has to offer or simply relax at the hotel and prepare for your late evening departure. Enjoy a farewell dinner at a Jerusalem Restaurant then transfer to Ben Gurion airport for your flight to Canada. [breakfast & dinner]

Day 10 – Thursday September 13

CANADA

Depart from Tel Aviv on El Al at 12:50am (just after midnight) flying non-stop to Toronto arriving at 6:45am at Pearson International airport (terminal 3), meals served on board.
