- Oct. 09 Afternoon departure from Toronto to Vienna.
- Oct. 10 Morning arrival in Vienna. Upon arrival transfer to Prague, the capital of Czech Republic, the “Golden City”. Dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 11 Full day in beautiful Prague. We celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Victory and see the renowned statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague. We visit the Old Town by the way of Golden Lane and then go to the Lesser Town to see the medieval Charles Bridge. We also see St. Nikolas Church, the Astronomic Clock and the Castle District where we tour St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George’s Basilica and Wenceslas Square. Some free time in the afternoon for shopping and rest. Dinner and overnight in Prague.
- Oct. 12 This morning we leave for Krakow, the ancient capital of Poland. En route we visit Wadowice, the birthplace of Pope John Paul II where we celebrate Mass. Upon arrival in Krakow time for rest, dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 13 Today we visit Czestochowa – the site of Poland’s greatest shrine – Our Lady of Czestochowa, also known as the “Black Madonna”, a pilgrimage destination that goes back to the 14th century. We celebrate Mass and venerate the priceless and miraculous icon. After returning to Krakow we explore its Old Town. We visit the Market Square where we hear the silver trumpet of the bugler from the tower of St. Mary’s Church. Many of the buildings around the square and in the Old Town are over 700 years old and include marvels such as the Town Hall Tower, the Cloth Hall and most of all the Wawel Royal Castle. Dinner and overnight in Krakow.
- Oct. 14 After breakfast we start with an excursion to the world-famous salt mines in Wieliczka. Afternoon we travel to Auschwitz, the notorious Nazi concentration camp. We visit a cell in which St. Maximilian Kolbe died and also the Martyrdom Museum recalling the horrors of the Holocaust and martyrdom of St. Edith Stein. Return to Krakow for dinner and overnight in Krakow.
- Oct. 15 This morning we visit Lagiewniki – world known as “Divine Mercy Shrine”. This is where St. Faustyna had had numerous visions of Christ, who told her to keep a diary of their encounters, during which he spoke to her of the Divine Mercy. We celebrate Mass and visit the convent of St. Faustyna, her tomb and relics. Continue to the Sanctuary dedicated to St. John Paul II. Some free time and return to our hotel for dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 16 After breakfast we depart Krakow on our way to Hungary through the picturesque mountains of Slovakia. Upon arrival in Budapest, the capital of Hungary time for rest, dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 17 Our sightseeing tour of Budapest starts with a visit to the 13th century St. Matthias Cathedral, the Citadel on Mt. Gellert, the Royal Castle, the Parliament, Hero’s Square and the St. Stephen Church. In the afternoon we depart for Vienna, the capital of Austria. Dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 18 Our tour of the city takes us to St. Stephen’s Cathedral, the Opera and the Schonbrunn Palace. In the afternoon some free time for leisure or shopping. Dinner and overnight. In the evening an optional concert.
- Oct. 19 After breakfast we are transferred to the airport in Vienna for a flight to Sarajevo in Bosnia. Upon arrival we board to bus a travel to Medjugorje. Some free time for rest, dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 20 Full day in Medjugorje. Time to visit the famous mountain of the Stations of the Cross and the Rosary Mountain. Mass, time for individual prayer, dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 21 Today we travel to Dubrovnik, one of the most beautiful towns in the Mediterranean in Croatia. We visit the mediaeval old town surrounded by walls, we see Bell Tower, Pile Gate, Onofrio Fountain and Placa Stradun. In the afternoon return to Medjugorje for dinner and overnight.
- Oct. 22 Early morning we depart to the airport in Sarajevo for a flight to Toronto via Vienna. Early afternoon arrival.

Please call, book online or send the registration form printed below. A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person is required at time of booking. Insurance must be purchased at time of booking.

BALANCE OF PAYMENT:

Balance due is payable 60 days prior to departure. For late bookings (within 60 days) full payment is due immediately.

CANCELLATION:

If cancellation is necessary, please advise IHT immediately in writing. Cancellation charges are as follows:

- 60 days before departure or earlier - \$300.00 per person
- between 60 and 45 days before departure – 50% of the total cost
- 45 days or less – 100% of the total cost

IF YOU CHANGE YOUR BOOKING:

A \$50.00 administration charge will be applied for changes you make to your booking outside the 45 days to departure period. Please note that name changes are not allowed and such will be treated as cancellations.

IF IHT CHANGES YOUR BOOKING:

IHT will advise you of any change we feel significantly alters the holiday which you have purchased from us. Occasionally, changes might occur close to departure time. In such cases, you will be notified as soon as possible. Due to circumstances beyond our control, the local tour operator may have to make last minute changes in hotel or schedule. We reserve the right to substitute any of the hotels with hotels in similar or better category. First class twin-bedded rooms with private facilities are used.

UNUSED SERVICES:

No refund or adjustment can be made for any portion of holiday not used.

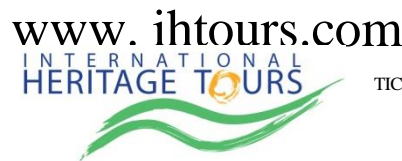
